Scoresheets – If your score is shown as “DNF”, and you shot all the stages, it is because there were no points down or no time recorded for a stage. It is the responsibility of the Safety Officer AND the shooter to make sure the scoresheet is filled in, and both should check and initial the scoresheet after every run of the stage. Since the Safety Officers are all volunteers and frequently (like last Saturday) working shorthanded, it behooves the shooter to double-check, if the score is important to him/her. Starting this month, no attempt will be made to contact shooters who do not mark their sheets with Division or Classification. If Classification is not marked, the score will be posted under “Unclassified”. If the Division is not marked, it will be posted under “Division Unknown”.

For newcomers – explanation of scoring

The first number under each stage is your total time for the stage. This is calculated by adding your raw time, plus additional time for points down and penalties. In the parenthesis is the number of points down for each stage. These are converted to seconds. Each point is worth a half a second. If you got a procedural (often given for shooting targets out of order) 3 seconds was added to your raw time. For other penalties see the rulebook.
