This is an **intermediate level** event. Students should have attended at least one 25m Project Appleseed clinic, as the fundamentals such as position, NPOA, and firing the shot are not detailed at a KD event.

- Test those 25 meter rifle skills at 200 yards
- Learn how to: Detect your Target, Estimate your Range, and Make the Shot at long-range

This is a real test of your rifleman skills, as the ballistics of a .22 caliber at 200 yards is similar to a centerfire rifle at close to 1,000 yards.

Participants are taught target detection methods, and how to estimate range without using a laser rangefinder, as well as the basics of trajectory. Wind reading, drag and gathering your DOPE are presented so you can master the 'Rifleman's Quarter Mile', an American tradition that has been part of this nation from its very first days.

So join us and hear some little-known Revolutionary War history of our early marksman, reaffirm your heritage, and make America a better place.

Having a good 50 yard zero will certainly speed things along!
