Sammie and Mark spoke to the General membership explaining why they felt that the club investing in the new Crossman Air Rifles was the correct way to lead the team forward and continue to advance the team. They were able to shoot the guns that we want to purchase and compared them to our current ones. They are much lighter, making easier to handle for our smaller shooters, they are easily adjustable to ensure we can fit these to our smallest and biggest kids, they are ambidextrous to allow each gun to be shot by either right or left handed shooters, the air tanks of the air rifles are regulated so that they can have the same pressure throughout the shots, along with having the ability to have 300 shots on one tank, which reduces the amount of needing to fill the cylinders.

 - With this the JR Team would like to Purchase 5 Crossman Air Rifles with the Executive board recommending that the club purchase 2 additional ones on top of this to give each of the active JR's a new gun to shoot with. – Second by Ed Duplantis – APPROVED by All members
 - The current Air Rifles will be offered to be sold to the members
- JR Rifle Team will also be submitting a submission to the Friends of the NRA Grant.
- The JR's Expressed that they would like to start Air Pistol
 - With that the Club will need to purchase some Air Pistols
 - JR Team would like to purchase 3 Pardini KID K12 Air Pistols from Champions Choice at \$1389 + tax and shipping – Second by Mark Bombara – APPROVED

Legislative & FOAC Reports:

FOAC Institute Press Release on City of York Ordinance: *Pittsburgh, PA* – FOAC-ILLEA renewed its call for Mayor Michael Helfirch of the City of York to veto legislation passed by city council this week. Bill No. 23 attempts to regulate firearms by restricting the possession, use, transfer or manufacture any “rapid-fire device.” The proposed ordinance violates Pennsylvania

Title 18, Section 6120. FOAC-ILLEA has won suits challenging laws enacted in Pittsburgh and Harrisburg, as well as several other municipalities across the state. The Courts, including the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania, have repeatedly ruled these communities that are trying to circumvent state preemption.
